Chapter 25: Medication Administration Oversight

- ☐ Right patient, right medication, right dose, right route, right time — verified independently, not just watched
 - ☐ High-alert medication (insulin, anticoagulant, opioid, IV push)? Direct co-sign required regardless of student level
 - ☐ Student explains the medication's purpose and key monitoring parameters before administering
 - ☐ Any hesitation or skipped verification step, even on a familiar medication → stop and re-verify together
